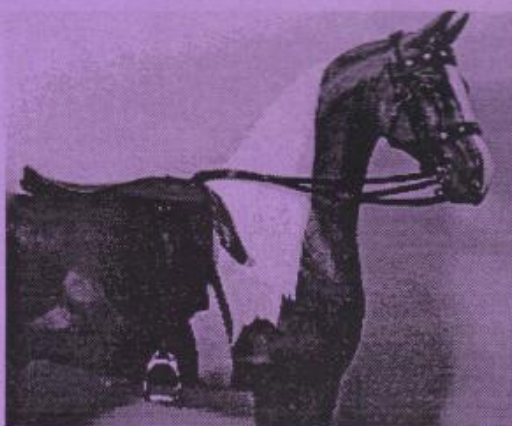

Dear Friends,

**WELCOME TO THE FIRST ANNUAL
NORTH AMERICAN NATIONALS!**

Just one year ago this weekend, during BreyerFest 1994, a group of showholders and other interested hobbyists met here in the Holiday Inn to launch a new organization: The North American Model Horse Shows Association. A month later, a second organizational meeting was held during the West Coast Model Horse Collectors Jamboree, and NAMHSA was on its way.

A year may seem like a long time, but it passes very quickly for busy people who are trying to create a national organization. In that year, NAMHSA has grown to over 30 member shows, elected officers and a Board of Directors, begun drafting bylaws, developed procedures, and, of course, organized the first North American Nationals – the NAN – the exciting event outlined in this program.

NAMHSA's aim is to promote all facets of the Model Horse Hobby and provide support for the future development of model horse showing, customizing, and collecting.

The philosophical direction of NAMHSA is to be an inclusive, promotional organization rather than to develop rules and regulations for model shows and exhibitors.

The services NAMHSA will eventually provide to the hobby include:

- promoting the model horse hobby to the public to develop interest, support, and recognition,
- building national and international communication about the model horse hobby,
- distributing information to bring new enthusiasts into the hobby,
- enhancing the prestige of member shows,
- developing young competitors and collectors as the future of the hobby,
- serving as a unifying organization for cooperation among model horse shows

and as a clearinghouse for information on shows and events, and

- offering new goals to model horse exhibitors by sponsoring a North American Nationals™ (NAN™) model horse show.

From its beginning, with a handful of people "having an idea" to a first national show with over 100 exhibitors, NAMHSA has already come a long way. But the organization is still only taking its first steps.

Everyone is welcome – and needed – to participate in whatever capacity you may choose. Perhaps you can support NAMHSA just by asking live showholders to join and so provide the opportunity to allow you to qualify for the NAN. Maybe you're interested in another aspect of NAMHSA, such as promoting the hobby. Do whatever is important to you – because NAMHSA belongs to the model horse hobby, not to any one person or group, and it can only flourish with your input and support.

Welcome, again, to the First Annual North American Nationals, and thank you for coming! Best of luck to every competitor, many thanks to the great number of volunteers who helped make it happen, and let's do it all again in 1996!

Performance Classes

PLEASURE/PARK/FINE HARNESS, includes all pleasure, park and fine harness entries, a TWH Show Pleasure Harness entry and a Morgan Carriage Pleasure Driving Entry.

DRAFT/WORKING HARNESS, includes all singles, pairs, and team hitch draft harness entries, all work harness entries, and a log pull contest entry.

EVENT/RACE/HISTORICAL HARNESS, includes all combined driving entries, harness race entries, as well as all historical entries including: an Antique Doctor's Buggy, Civil War Period Harness, and "Small Town Parade".

HUNTER, includes field hunter and handy hunter entries.

SIDESADDLE/OTHER ENGLISH SHOWRING CLASS, includes all English Sidesaddle entries, leadline entries, command class entries, equitation, and roadster under saddle and drafter under saddle.

RACE/OTHER NON-SHOWRING TRADITION, includes all race entries, endurance entries (as entered in the Other English section), long-lines, polo, foxhunt entries and Spanish Riding School entries.

PLEASURE/LOW ACTION GAITED, includes all English pleasure (saddleseat), plantation pleasure (TWHs), and paso pleasure classes, as well as in-hand showmanship entries.

PARK/HIGH ACTION GAITED, includes all park, five-gaited performance, and big lick entries.

ENGLISH/SADDLESEAT TRAIL, includes both natural trail and arena trail entries for horses competing under huntseat or saddleseat tack.

NOVELTY GAMES, includes a great variety of gymkhana games including: egg & spoon, barrel crawl, apple bobbing, musical sacks and many others.

TRADITIONAL SPEED GAMES, includes barrel race, flag race, pole bending, keyhole race, relay race and Pony Club Rally Race.

CUTTING/PENNING/RANCHWORK, includes cutting, reined cowhorse, team penning, ranchwork, and rangework with cattle and/or sheep.

ROPING/OTHER RODEO CONTEST, includes calf roping, team roping, bulldogging and break and out.

OTHER WESTERN PERFORMANCE, includes Western sidesaddle, coon jumping, Western bareback, farm work, endurance (as registered in Other Western), equitation, horseball, hunting outfitter, and lead line entries.

HISTORICAL/TRADITIONAL COSTUME, includes medieval, native paso, cavalry and military costume, plus Roman, Japanese, Spanish, "Native Andalusian Parade" and "Regency Romance".

ENTERTAINMENT/NOVELTY COSTUME, includes circus costume, vaulting and trick riding, trick roping, rodeo queen, rodeo grand entry, Halloween costume, birthday party costume, plus "Brunhilde" and a "Guideless Wonder".
